

Bus Trip Etiquette







Here are a few reminders before leaving on a bus trip.

1. CHECK THE DATE AND TIME OF DEPARTURE

Mark your calendar! Please remember due to time restraints at different stops to and from each location and possible weather, the bus cannot wait for late arrivals so please be on time.

2. BELONGINGS TO TAKE ON THE BUS

Only small, soft side, 6pk ice chests are allowed on the bus due to space concerns. Most skiers bring a sack dinner to eat on the way. It is also nice to have snacks, cards, reading material, flashlight, paper and pencil. Be sure to bring a blanket and a pillow. These will need to be stored overhead or under your seat, so be very conservative.

3. WEAR LOOSE COMFORTABLE CLOTHING

You will be sleeping in them. There is no place to change on the bus. It is also a good idea to wear shoes that are easy to get on and off.

4. BAGGAGE UNDER THE BUS

You are limited to 1 suitcase, 1 small bag, 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag per person. Space under the bus is limited so pack accordingly.

5. SEATING ASSIGNMENTS FOR THE BUS

A list will be posted in the front of the bus. Remember, f you sign up early and pay in full you get to pick your seat location.

6. NO SMOKING

This is a non-smoking bus. You will have to wait until we reach our scheduled stops and then exit the bus to smoke! Please do not embarrass yourself by smoking on the bus even in the bathroom, it is expressly forbidden by federal law.

7. CHANGE ROOMS

Upon arrival and departure we may or may not need to use change rooms before and after skiing. That being said, it is a good idea for husbands and wives to pack separately and have the first days ski clothing on top.

8. AIRPORT PARKING DEPARTURE

Upon exiting the parking lot from each trip, please enter the exit line to pay for parking "only" after you have your ticket and payment ready to avoid delays of everyone.
