Luggage:

Large Suitcase (Approximately 31x18x12)

Medium Suitcase (Approximately 27x16x10)

- 1<sup>st</sup> bag (either size) will be taken when we arrive at the airport. It will be sent to Hakuba and you won't see it until we arrive at the mountain at the hotel. This bag will have all of your mountain gear and anything you don't need in Tokyo.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> bag (either size) you will keep with you in Tokyo the entire time with your Tokyo clothing and what you take to Hakuba day 1 on the bus. You will be responsible for moving it around so don't overpack it. Toiletries, medication, etc.
- 1 bag (Larger suitcase) will be packed and sent back to the airport when we depart Hakuba. You will not see this bag again until we arrive back at the airport to come home. It needs to be ready to be checked at the airport. You might be able to stuff a few things in it at the airport but don't count on it. **NOTE: You can keep both bags with you until Kyoto but realize you are responsible for loading/unloading them on the bus when we change locations.**
- 1 bag (medium Suitcase) will travel with you when we leave Hakuba and travel to Kanazawa and Kyoto.
- If you still have 2 bags with you in Kyoto when we depart the large will be taken from you and returned to the Airport. The size of luggage is limited on the bullet train to 30x20x10 (which will be a medium size or smaller). You must be able to lift it into the overhead storage. Otherwise it stays at your feet and you have no legroom.
- When we arrive at the airport to depart any luggage that had been "caged" will be collected and available.
- IMPORTANT: Once the bags are caged and depart they cannot be retrieved. If you forget something you will have to buy a new one. Be very careful where you pack medication if you take it.
